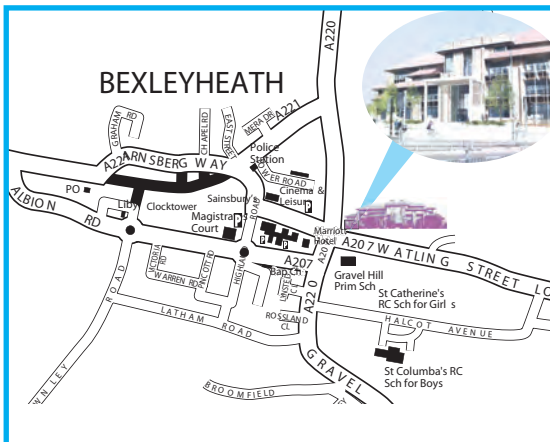

How to find us



By road: From the M25, turn onto the A2 at junction 2 (South Orbital Roundabout) and follow towards London.

From London and the Blackwall Tunnel follow the A2 coast-bound.

Exit at the "Black Prince Interchange" and follow signs for A220, Bexleyheath up Gravel Hill. The Civic Offices is at the junction with Watling Street and the reception is at the front of the building facing the junction.

Nearest car parks: Albion Road public car park and Cinema public car park

By rail: The nearest station is Barnehurst and is 15-20 minutes walk from the office.

By bus: The following routes stop in the town centre at Bexleyheath clock tower, a few minutes walk away: 89, 96, 132, 229, 269, 401, 422, 469, 486, 492, B11, B13, B14, B15 and B16

The following routes stop near the Civic Offices: 96, 132, 229, 492, B12.
